WHAT YOU WILL RECEIVE · V1.0 · PENDING FOUNDER SIGN-OFF

A written Threshold Family review is a structured, evidence-led read of the situation you describe. It is not a legal opinion, not a clinical diagnosis, and not a substitute for statutory processes. The deliverable

1. Named reviewer and Founder sign-off

Every Threshold Family review is authored by a named ORVIA reviewer and signed by the Founder before it is issued to you.

2. Chronology of events

A neutral, dated timeline built from the documents you supply, with each entry footnoted to its source.

3. Findings against the evidence

Plain-English findings that separate what the evidence supports, what it does not, and where important information is missing.

4. The person at the centre

A short section that returns the situation to the individual — likely effects on the child, adult or family member concerned.

5. Options and next steps

A shortlist of realistic next steps you could consider — not directions to take.

6. What is out of scope

A named list of the things this review does NOT do (e.g. legal representation, statutory investigation, clinical assessment).

7. Retention and deletion terms

How long we keep your evidence, when we delete it, and how you get confirmation of deletion in writing.

How it moves

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This service follows the ORVIA enquiry journey — every enquiry passes Gate One (suitability), then Gate Two (controlled onboarding) before any evidence is examined. See the How it works page on orvia.org.uk for the full flow.

Every issued document carries a named ORVIA reviewer, a Founder sign-off, a version number and a date. Findings are footnoted to the source material supplied to us.
